

Comments on the « Review of the scientific information on lead; Revised draft of 18 Aug 2006 »

Page 9, Para. (paragraph) 30 : Please, add a reference after the following sentence “ Since Sub-Saharan Africa completely eliminated the import and production of leaded gasoline in January 2006”.

Page 9, Para. 31: At the end of the second sentence, please separate the figure “92” and the word “percent”.

In addition, throughout this review, please abbreviate “percent” as “%” as indicated in the abbreviation section.

Page 10, Para. 34: In the third sentence of this paragraph, please replace the dots by commas in the following figures “200000 - 260000”. And add the unit “tonnes” after these figures.

Throughout this review, please, use the symbol “t” for “tonne”, and “1000 Tonnes” can be abbreviated as “kt”.

Page 11, Para. 43: In the first sentence, instead of writing “3,600,000”, please write this figure using the unit “million” to get “3.6 millions” for consistency with the next figure which is “3.1 millions”.

This conversion can be used for all figures in millions in this review to ease the reading of large figures.

Page 15, Para. 59; Second Bullet and First Hyphen: Please, check up this sentence. There is an omission at the end.

Second Bullet and Second Hyphen: The first word of this sentence is unreadable.

Page 27, Para. 108: In the last sentence, please put a space between the words “and” and “contributed”.

Page 29, Para. 113: In the second sentence, please, add the letter “a” or “b” to the reference “U.S. EPA (1998)” to it to be relevant with references in the References section.

Page 29, Para. 116: Isotopes are usually superscripted before an element: for example “²⁰⁸Pb” and not “₂₀₈Pb”. Please, use the symbol “%” for “percent”. Then the last part of the second sentence of this paragraph can become “Organic lead ... four stable isotopes: ²⁰⁸Pb (51-53 %), ²⁰⁶Pb (23.5-27 %), ²⁰⁷Pb (20.5-23 %) and ²⁰⁴Pb (1.35-1.5 %) (U.S. ATDSR, 2006)”.

Page 30, Para. 124: In the second sentence, the following words “in the study from 1977” can be deleted.

Page 30, Para. 125: In the third sentence, please put a space between the words: “Tetra-methyl” and “lead”; “tetra-ethyl” and “lead”; “gas” and “phase”.

Page 31, Para. 132: In the first sentence, please, add the letter “a” or “b” to the reference “U.S. EPA (2005)” to it to be relevant with references in the References section.

Page 33, Figure 2-1 (Caption): Please, put a space between the words “brackets” and “after”.

Page 35, Para. 154: In the first sentence, please, delete the dot (.) after the word “deficits”.

In the second sentence, replace the word “form” by “from”.

In the last sentence, please, delete “a” between “even” and “that”.

Page 35, Para. 155: Please, delete the comma (,) after the word “al.”

Page 35, Para. 156: In the last sentence, please, replace “B-Pb” by “Pb-B”. And, the reference “U.S. EPA, 1988” is absent in the References section.

Page 36, Para. 164: In the first sentence, please, replace the word “wary” by “vary”.

The reference “NFA, 2002” is absent in the References section.

Page 37, Table 3-1: the reference “Burkina Faso submission, 2005” is absent in the References section.

Page 37, Para. 167: In the last sentence, the reference “Lanphear et al., 1998” is absent in the References section.

Page 37, Para. 168: In the middle of this paragraph, the reference “U.S. EPA, 1986a” is absent in the References section. Towards the end of this paragraph, references “EPA, 1986a” and “Burkina Faso Submission, 2005” are also absent in the References section.

Page 41, Para. 179: In the last sentence, please, delete the dot (.) before the reference and put it at the end of the sentence.

Page 42, Para. 186: Please, put a space between the words “tetramethyl” and “lead”.

Page 47, Para. 219: In the last sentence, please, replace “cadmium” by “lead”

Page 47, Para. 222: In the third sentence, please, delete “with” after “laboratory tests”.

Page 49, Para. 229: Add the word “submission” between the word “Australia” and the year “(2005)” in the middle of this paragraph.

Page 50, Para. 234: In the last sentence, please, delete the dot (.) before the reference and put it after the reference.

Page 51, Para. 239: In the beginning of this paragraph, please, delete the brackets before and after the year “2005”, and put the reference “Shotyk et al, 2005” in the brackets.

Page 52, Para. 241: Please, utilize the unit “million” to facilitate the reading of figures.

Page 54, Para. 245: Towards the end of this paragraph, please, delete the dot (.) before the reference (ESPROME, 2006).

Page 56, Figure 5-2 (Caption): please, put a space between “1990-2003” and “UNECE, 2006”.

Page 57, Below Table 5-5: please, superscript “1”.

Page 57, Para. 250 and 251: Please, utilize the unit “million” to facilitate the reading of figures.

Page 58, Para. 253: In the second sentence, please, check up the section in which this sentence referred to. May be not “section 3.2” as mentioned.

Page 59, Para. 257: Please, utilize the unit “million” to facilitate the reading of figures.

Page 63, Para. 275: in the first sentence, please, put a comma (,) between “the tailings” and “the tailings”.

Page 63, Para. 277: The reference “Ecuador’s Submission, 2006) is absent in the References section.

Page 64, Para. 279: Please, employ the unit “million” to facilitate the reading of figures.

Page 64, Table 6-1 (Title): Please, put the word “in” before the year “2004”.

Page 64, Table 6-1 Please, delete the year “2004” mentioned in the entries of Table 6-1.

Instead of “1000 tonnes”, the abbreviation “kt” can be used.

Please, superscript the figure “1” at the bottom of this table.

Page 66, Table 6-2: Instead of “1000 tonnes”, the abbreviation “kt” can be used.

Please, delete the definition about the secondary lead at the bottom of Table 6-2, since it has been defined in the previous page.

Page 67, Table 6-3: Instead of “1000 tonnes”, the abbreviation “kt” can be used.

Page 67, Para. 289: Please, employ the unit “million” to facilitate the reading of figures.

Page 68, Table 6-4: Instead of “1000 tonnes”, the abbreviation “kt” can be used.

Please, superscript the figure “1” at the bottom of this table.

Page 70, Table 6-5: Instead of “1000 tonnes”, the abbreviation “kt” can be used.

Please, superscript the figures “1”, “2”, “3” and “4” at the bottom of this table.

Page 70, Para. 301: Please, employ the unit “million” to facilitate the reading of figures.

Page 71, Table 6-6: Instead of “1000 tonnes”, the abbreviation “kt” can be used.

Please, superscript “1” at the bottom of this table.

Page 72, Table 6-7: Please, superscript “1” at the bottom of this table.

Page 74, Para. 311: The reference “Morocco submission, 2005” in this paragraph is absent in the References section.

Page 76: Since Table 6-9 continues in Page 76, please, replace “Table 6-10” by “Table 6-9”.

Page 77, Para. 317: At the end of the sentence before the last sentence, delete the dot (.) after the word “sources”.

In the last sentence, write the word “in” in small letters.

Page 79: Since Table 7-1 continues in Page 79, please, replace “Table 7-2” by “Table 7-1”.

Page 82, Para. 331: The reference “Working Group on Effects, 2005” in this paragraph is absent in the References section.

Page 84, Figure 7-7 (a): please, put a space between “Czeck” and “Rep”

Page 98, Para. 383: In this paragraph, please, superscript each isotopes of Pb as ²⁰⁴Pb, ²⁰⁶Pb, ²⁰⁷Pb and ²⁰⁸Pb.

The reference “Sangster et al., 2000” in the first sentence is absent in the References section.

Also, in the second sentence, references “Rosman et al., 1993; Sturges and Barrie, 1989 and Sturges et al., 1993” are absent in the References section.

In the middle of this paragraph, please, delete the “a” after the year “2001” on the reference “Gobeil et al., 2001”.

At the end of this paragraph, please write “Macdonald et al. 2005” and not “Macdonals et al., 2005”.

Page 99, Para. 387: The reference “Broecker, 1991” in the first sentence of this paragraph is absent in the References section.

Page 101, Para. 395: The reference “MSC-E, 2005” in this paragraph is absent in the References section.

Page 104, Table 8-1: Please, superscript “1” in the column with the title “Price relative to lead technology”.

The reference “Maag et al., 2001b” in the third cell of the column with the title “Alternatives”, is absent in the References section.

Page 105, Table 8-1 continued: Please, superscript “1” in the column with the title “Price relative to lead technology”.

Page 106, Table 8-1 continued: Please, superscript “1” in the column with the title “Price relative to lead technology”.

Page 107, Table 8-1 continued: Please, superscript “1” in the column with the title “Price relative to lead technology”.

Page 108, Table 8-1 continued: Please, superscript “1” in the column with the title “Price relative to lead technology”.

Please, also, superscript “1” at the bottom of this table.

Page 113: please, write “Table 8-3 (continued)” at the top of the table on this page.

Page 114: please, write “Table 8-3 (continued)” at the top of the table on this page.

Page 122, Para. 450: In the third sentence, please replace “is releases” by “is released”.

Page 122, Para. 452: At the end of the second sentence, please put a full stop after “Japanese incinerators”.

Page 123, Table 8-7: Please, superscript the numbers “1”, “2” and “3” at the bottom of this table.

Please, put a comma (,) between “al” and “1995” for the first reference.

Page 134, Para. 520: The reference “OSPAR Commission, 2004” at the end of this paragraph is absent in the References section.

Page 147, Para. 601: At the end of the fourth bulleted sentence, replace “cadmium” by “lead”.

Page 148, Para. 601: The sixth bulleted sentence of this paragraph seems to be incomplete.

Page 151: please ,add “kt” and abbreviation of “1000 tonnes”.

Figure and Table numbering: To avoid a confused reading of figure and table numbers of the **Extended Summary** section with those of other sections of this review, please use a numbering different from that of “1”, “2”, “3”, ..., “8”. For example, “i”, “ii”, “iii” ... “viii” may be applied.

Page 153 – 154 - 155: Please, delete the words “et al.” before the year in the references “39”, “45”, “67” and “87”.

Page 154: please, check up the reference “77”. It seems that it should be “EU SCOOP, 2003” and not “EU SCOOP, 2004”.

Page 155: In the reference “115”, put a space between “trialkyl” and “lead”.

Page 157: In the reference “170”, instead of “Marocco...”, please write “Morocco ...”.

Page 159: please delete the reference “211” since it already exists as the reference “92”.

Page 160: please, check up the reference “245”. It seems to be “from exposure ...” and not “form exposure ...”.

Page 161: In the reference “276”, please, put a space between “1500” and “AD” and between “1989” and “AD”.

In the reference “286”, please superscript the Pb isotope as “²⁰³Pb”

ANNEX I

From the ID 1 to 9: This section should be checked since some omissions about the term “cadmium” seem to appear where the word “lead” should be used.

Please, delete **ID 10**, since it’s just a repetition of **ID 9**.

In **ID 22 (Japan)**, please, put a space between “16.9” and “ppm”.

Check up **ID 40 (Poland)**: It seems an omission appears by using the term “cadmium” instead of “lead”.
