Dear Mr. Bakken:

As an environmental artist since 2003, I had devoted my self to communicate through my art work relevant issues regarding endangered species, climate change, deforestation and ecosystem & biodiversity lost, and more recently food & energy security promoting sustainable agro business.

Since 2008, I became cofounders of the Zero Pollution Alliance, helping implement Corporate Social Responsibility projects orient it to reduce, reuse, and recycle or elimination of at least 10 dangerous pollutants from our environment. As the first pollutant, we considered the voluntary reduction of grocery bags or non reusable plastic bags, as is happening around the world. We set a goal to reach in 12 months 20 thousand reusable bags and to be distributed among customers and employees of large supermarkets chains as stepping stones for bigger programs inside supermarkets and grocery stores, among others, in the republic of Panama. We had already achieved 90% of our goal and in the first year we created awareness among big users to change habits.

The next important pollutant is mercury-contained products, electrical products as well in medical instrument and dental amalgam. We just started to create awareness of the program and the impacts of mercury containing products on the environment & human health among the public.

This year we will start a project denominated "Mision Mercurio Cero" to reach at least 20,000 locations/persons in the province of Panama and collect 8 tones of mercury containing products or 200 kg of mercury in used batteries, thermometer, electric & medical instruments and dental amalgam in the next 12 months and create temporary warehousing, neutralize & cementation and rehabilitate a contaminated site in Panama as part of a public art project designed by me. We just started the program in June 5, 2009 celebrating the Environment World Day.

I look forward to be a positive partner of the Global Mercury Program as well as in other present and future programs regarding reduction of toxic pollutants in the world.

What is the UNEP Global Mercury Partnership?

The UNEP Global Mercury Partnership is a voluntary and collaborative relationship amongst various parties, governmental, non-governmental, public and private, in which all participants agree to work together in a systematic way to achieve the goal of the UNEP Global Mercury Partnership.

The UNEP Global Mercury Partnership complements and supports the implementation of UNEP Governing Council Decision 24/3.

As of June 2008, the following partnership areas have been initiated:

- artisanal and small scale gold mining;
- mercury cell chlor alkali production;
- mercury air transport and fate research;
- mercury in products;
- mercury releases from coal combustion; and
- mercury waste management.

Other partnership areas are in the process of being considered and initiated.

What is the Overall Goal of the UNEP Global Mercury Partnership?

The overall goal of the UNEP Global Mercury Partnership is to protect human health and the global environment from the release of mercury and its

compounds by minimizing and, where feasible, ultimately eliminating global, anthropogenic mercury releases to air, water and land.

- Contributing resources or expertise to the development and implementation of partnership activities.
